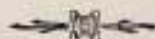

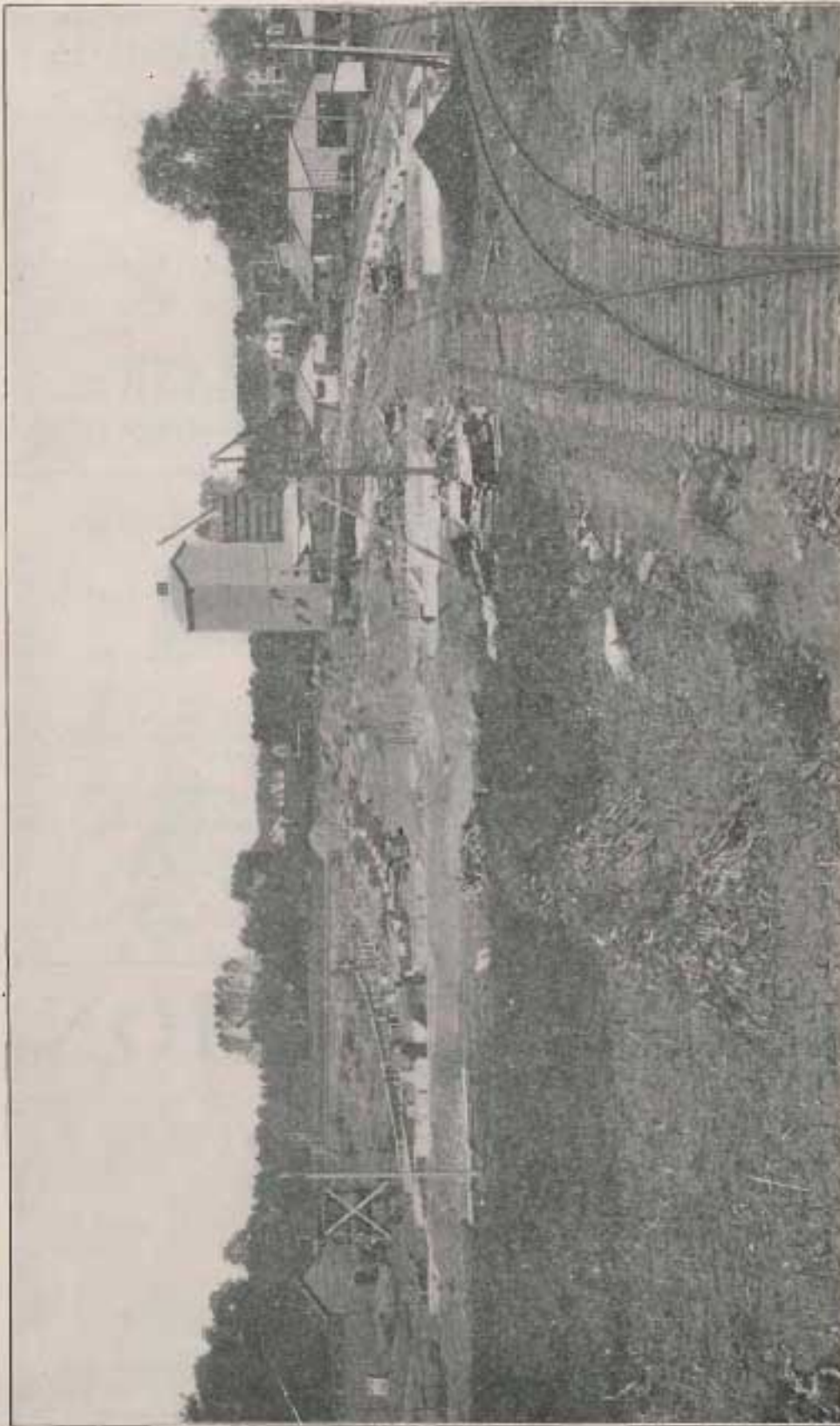

In the foreground you see the "nerve" of the great Stadium "horoscope" at the southwest "peg", as it looks today. The width of the "peg", or Stadium "fence", is 150 feet. And it will be 707 feet high. To the left, protected by wire fence, is the future "Varsity gridiron, already sodded for next year.

Contributors of \$5000 or more will have a box off the field named in their honor and will be entitled to an option on the box or as many seats in it as they desire.

Names of all subscribers of \$100 or more will be perpetuated on bronze tablets, to be located prominently in the new Stadium.

Students giving \$25 will receive the same benefits as Alumni and friends who give \$100.

COMMON PENALTIES

Loss of Two Yards

Time taken out more than three times during a half.

Loss of Five Yards

Violation of off-side rule; illegal positions. Players attempting fair catch taking more than two steps after catch. Interference with opponents before ball is put in play. Delay of game.

Loss of Ten Yards

Intentional throwing of forward pass to ground.

Loss of Fifteen Yards

Interference with fair catch. Pushing, pulling, interlocked interference. Holding, by side in possession of ball. Tripping, tackling, out of bounds. Unsportsmanlike conduct.

Loss of Twenty-five Yards

Team not ready to play at start of second half.

Loss of Half Distance to Goal Line

Player disqualified for striking, kneeling, kicking.

Loss of a "Down"

Interference by side making forward pass prior to fourth down. Forward pass striking ground prior to fourth down. Illegal substitution (return to game)

Loss of Ball

Interference by defensive side in case of forward pass. If forward pass be illegally recovered or touched by passer's side. Offside player touching ball.

Disqualification

Striking, kneeling, kicking. Cutting down (running into) opponent after ball is dead.

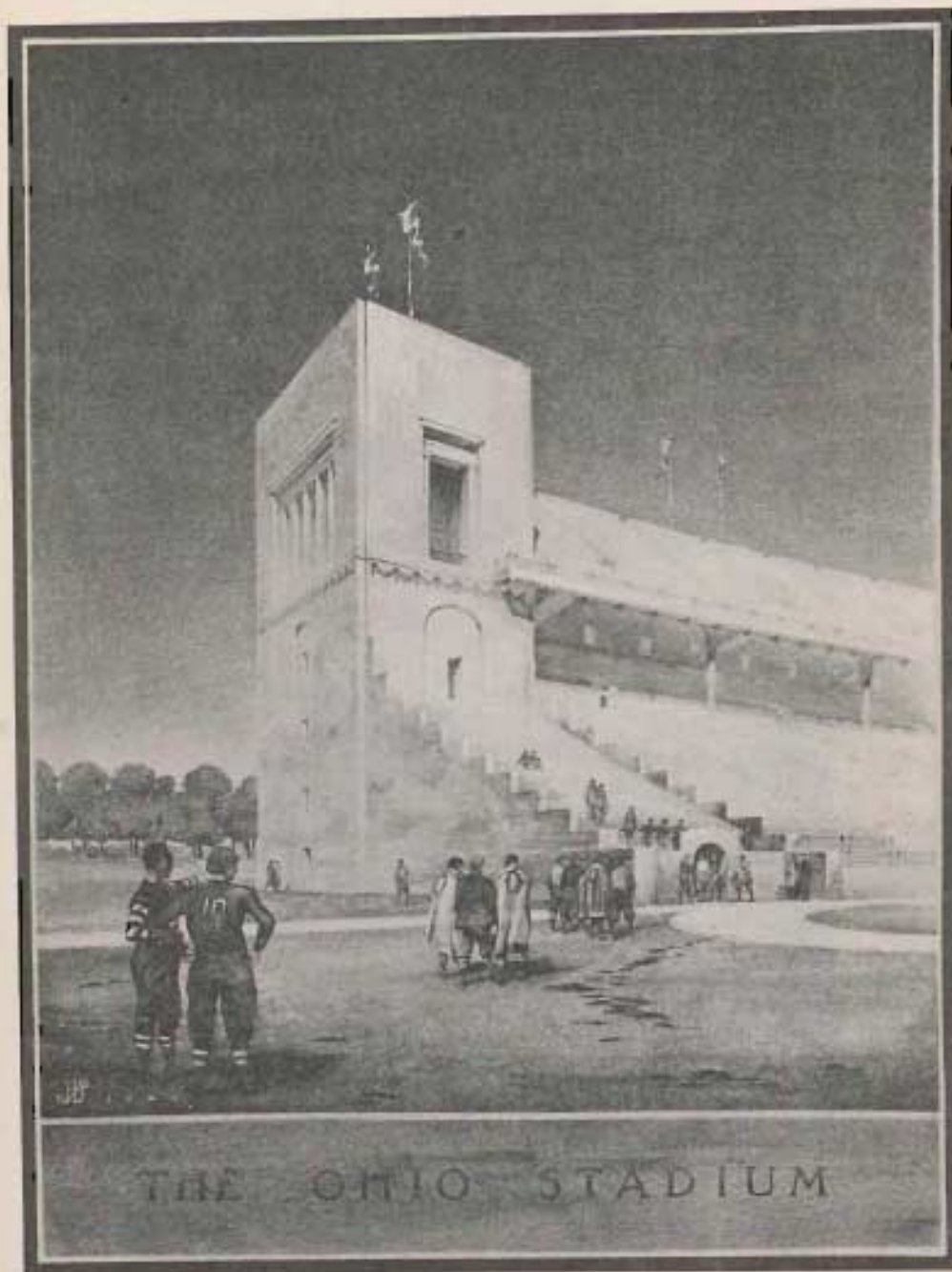

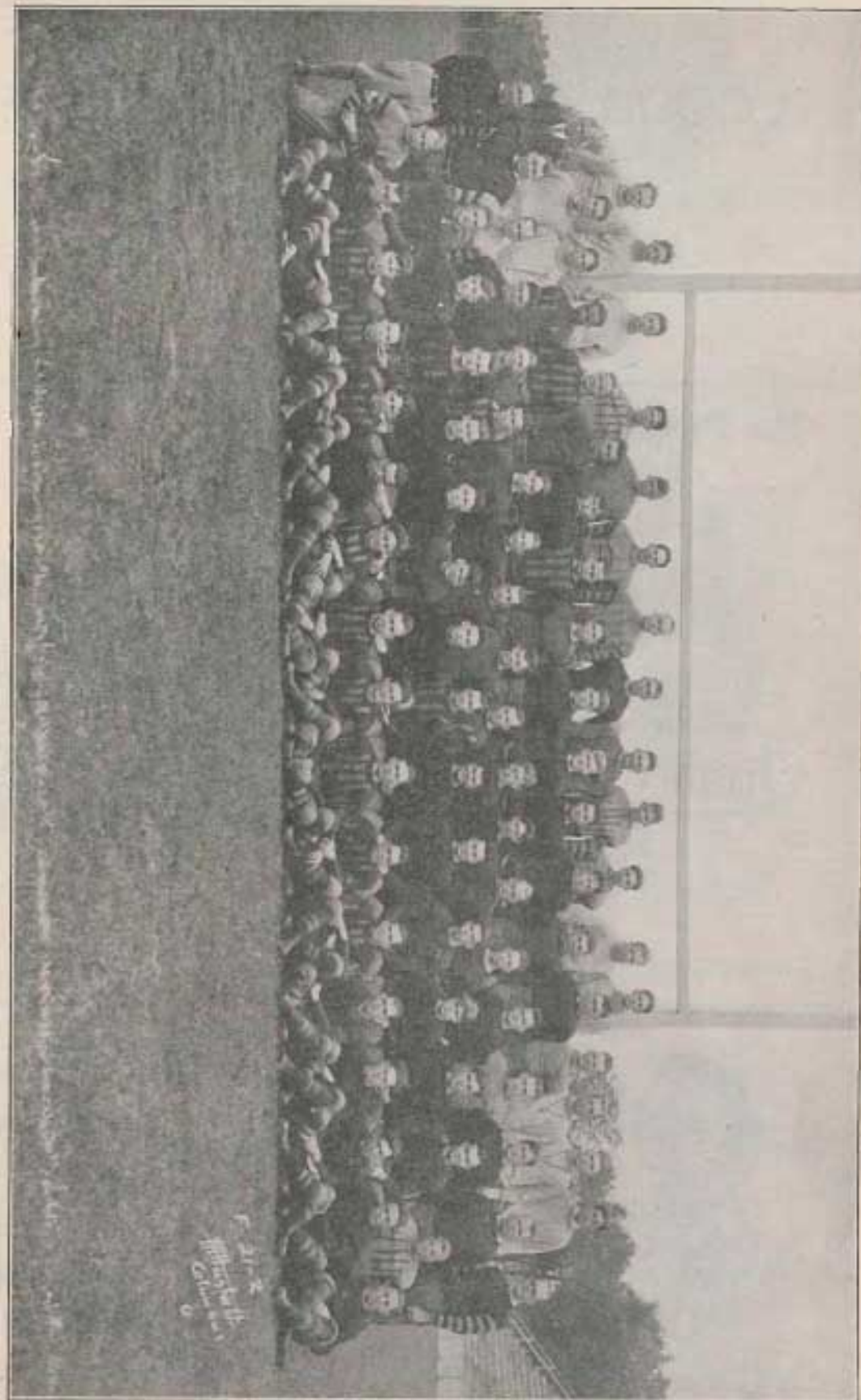

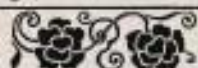
